

Budget Billing Plan Terms and Conditions

As a Dancer within our PPL Program, Company Dancer and/or Elite Member we offer a budget billing plan to spread the cost of conventions, competitions, and company costumes over the entire 12 month term rather than lump sums invoiced to your account.

Items that are included in the Budget Billing Plan

- Conventions
- Competition fees
- Costumes (both Company and Showcase)

To have your account put on the Budget Billing Plan, please email busmgr@stoughtonperformingarts.com the following information:

1. Name of Student
2. Which Conventions your daughter will be attending for the 2018-19 Season (please see 2018-19 PPL and Company Dancer informational pdf for more details and information):
 - a. Hollywood Vibe – St. Louis in November
 - b. Jump – Chicago in January
 - c. Hollywood Vibe – Chicago in March (1/2 price convention tuition if you attended St Louis)
 - d. NUVO – Chicago in March
3. We will track and add to your plan the number of Company pieces she is in.
4. If your daughter has a solo, which competitions she would like to compete her solo at:
 - a. Hollywood Vibe- St Louis in November
 - b. Jump – Chicago in January
 - c. Imagine – Sauk Prairie in February
 - d. Hollywood Vibe – Chicago in March
 - e. Applause – Middleton in March
 - f. NUVO – Chicago in March
5. We will track and add to your plan the number of Company Costumes she has.
6. What showcase classes your daughter will be taking for the 2018-19 Season so we can estimate and add those costumes to your billing plan.

Once we have the above information we will compile a grand total of costs that include convention tuition, competition fees, and estimated costume costs. We will then divide that number by 11 (if we receive your information by August 1st, for a billing plan that would run August 1st 2018 to July 31st 2019) or by 10 (if we receive your information by September 1st, for a billing plan that would run September 1st 2018 to July 31st 2019).

The billing plan amount (along with monthly tuition and company fees if applicable) will be charged to your card on file each month. Each item will be invoiced as usual (costume deposits in Oct/Nov, convention and competition fees in Oct/Jan, costume balances in Feb). It is likely that your July 2019 invoice will not be the same as your billing plan amount, as the estimates that we did on costumes and the actual cost of each costume would create a discrepancy by the end of the plan. It is our every intention to ensure that July invoice is less than your normal billing plan amount, however we cannot guarantee that.

Please note there is \$25 annual set up fee for the budget billing plan to cover the administrative costs in estimating, calculating, and setup.
